Governor weighing decision about whether to sign pro-life bill; phone calls needed

Governor Brad Henry has three days remaining in which to decide whether to **veto, or sign into law**, Senate Bill 1878. Last year, Governor Henry vetoed a major pro-life bill.



Please phone the Governor and ask that he sign Senate Bill 1878 into law.

Governor Henry is being urged by abortion advocates to veto the pro-life bill. It is vitaly important that he hear from pro-life Oklahomans urging him to sign Senate Bill 1878 into law. The Governor's phone number is (405) 521-2342. (There is no after- hours voice mail.)

The bill passed the Senate, 38-10, on April 9, after having passed the House of Representatives, 80-12, on April 2. To see how senators voted, click [here](#). To see how representatives voted, click [here](#). The "Yeas" are pro-life, the "Nays" are pro-abortion.
